



COONGIE LAKES & CORNER COUNTRY ITINERARY

- Day 1 Depart Adelaide approx 8am travelling via Morgan to a bush camp in the award winning Gluepot reserve. An evening walk birding.
- Day 2 Early morning birding before heading further into the Bookmark Biosphere. We travel through Calperum Station into Danggali Conservation Park for an overnight camp.
- Day 3 From Danggali we head north east into NSW via Broken Hill for a two night camp at Mutawintji National Park.
- Day 4 A day exploring the Aboriginal heritage of this spectacular National Park.
- Day 5 Leaving Mutawintji we head north to Tibooburra and an overnight camp in Sturt National Park.
- Day 6 We travel through Cameron Corner and head towards the Cooper Creek via the bore track. We camp for two nights on Cullyamurra waterhole.
- Day 7 A mornings walk & birding along this section of the Cooper Creek.
- Day 8 We top up with supplies at Innamincka before heading north to Coongie Lakes. Coongie Lakes is listed as a Ramsar Wetland of International Importance.
- Day 9 A day walk around the lakes area observing the evidence of ancient aboriginal campsites and the wonderful birdlife for which this region is known.
- Day 10 Travelling back to Innamincka we head south past Moomba into the Strzelecki desert for an overnight camp at Montecollina bore.
- Day 11 We take the time looking for the Chestnut Breasted Whiteface around Lyndhurst before heading south to Camp on the western side of the Flinders Ranges.
- Day 12 Return to Adelaide via Quorn arriving approx. 4pm.
