KANGAROO ISLAND - 8 days

DAY 1

Depart Adelaide approximately 7am to catch the ferry from Cape Jervis to Penneshaw. The ferry takes one hour. To picturesque American River for lunch, then Seal Bay to mingle with Australian sea lions before making camp at Flinders Chase for five nights.

DAY 2

We travel to Kelly Hill Caves for a 9 km walk passing through tall Sugar Gum country, lagoons, wooded sand hills, and finally along the South West River to the wild coastline at Hanson Bay. A short afternoon walk and a tour of the caves.

DAY 3

A visit to Cape du Couedic [the South West tip of the Island] to view Admirals Arch and Remarkable Rocks then an evening walk to view platypus along Rocky River.

DAY 4

Today we visit West Bay, take a short walk along the Breakneck River and a walk down Rocky River to the Coast and back along Sandy Creek.

DAY 5

To the North West tip of the Island at Cape Borda and the Ravine de Casoars where we can observe penguins in the limestone caves abutting the beach. [3.5 hr walk]. We view the highest cliffs in SA and visit Harvey's Return, once the landing point for supplies to the lighthouse.

DAY 6

We move camp to Brownlow Beach on the North Coast via a scenic drive to Western River Cove, Stokes Bay and Emu Bay. We also visit Reeve's Point, the first formal settlement of South Australia.

DAY 7

We visit Duck Lagoon at Cygnet River and the Gum Creek marron farm before heading to Chapman River for lunch. An afternoon drive to the eastern end of the Island to Cape Willoughby lighthouse and a nights camp at Penneshaw.

DAY 8

Return via ferry to the mainland. A walk in the second Valley forest before lunch and returning to Adelaide approx 4.30pm. FARES INCLUDE FERRY.
