## LAWN HILL/CARNARVON GORGE - 21 days

- Day 1* Depart Adelaide approx. 7am travelling via Clare, Jamestown, Orroroo, and Hawker to Marree on the Oodnadatta Track. Caravan park.
- Day 2* We travel up the Birdsville track to Birdsville and camp the night on the banks of the Diamantina River. Bush camp.
- Day 3* The route continues almost due north up the Diamantina development road through the town of Bedourie to Boulia and beyond. Bush camp
- Day 4* Mornings run to Mt Isa and into camp. A visit to the Riversleigh Fossil Centre and look around the town in the afternoon. Caravan park.
- Day 5* We continue north west along the Barkly Highway then north to our campsite on the Gregory River. In the afternoon we visit the Riversleigh palaeontology site.
- Day 6* After a relaxing morning we enter the tropical oasis of Lawn Hill National Park for a three night camp.
- Day 7-8* Swimming, canoeing and walking park trails in the National Park.
- Day 9* Travel along the Matilda highway and south to a camp in Cloncurry. Caravan park.
- Day 10* A visit to the Flying Doctor Museum and on to Winton for a wander through this historic town before heading out into Bladensburg National Park for the night's camp. Bush camp.
- Day 11* Drive to Longreach and an afternoon in the Stockman's Hall of Fame. The night's camp is in Longreach. Caravan park.
- Day 12* Travel to Emerald for most of the day plus a visit to the botanic gardens.
- Day 13* To Carnarvon Gorge arriving lunchtime to camp for 4 nights. Caravan park.
- Day 14-16* Walks along the main gorge visiting the many varied and spectacular side Gorges in this sub tropical white sandstone country.
- Day 17* We travel due south through Roma to St George. Caravan park.
- Day 18* From St George the route continues south through Hebel and Brewarrinna to Bourke, then on to Gundabooka National Park to camp the night. Bush camp.
- Day 19* The morning exploring Gundabooka before an afternoon drive down the Darling River to camp at Wilga in the Paroo Darling NP. Bush camp.
- Day 20* A morning travelling to Broken Hill and an afternoon sightseeing as we visit the Sculpture Symposium in the Living Desert Park and the recently revived ghost town of Silverton. We camp the night in Broken Hill.
- Day 21* Continue along the Barrier Highway arriving in Adelaide at approx. 4.45pm.
