



# Kimberley Safari



Starting from Darwin, we head south through Katherine & then west to Timber Creek. We visit Keep River National Park, Lake Argyle and Kununurra whilst looking around the Ord River irrigation scheme.



The Gibb River Road leads us to Mornington Sanctuary, Windjana Gorge & Tunnel Creek. Beyond this we discover Derby, Broome and Geikie Gorge where we cruise on the mighty Fitzroy River. Next we make a bee-line for Purnululu National Park (The Bungles), with a three night stop, giving us plenty of time to relax. As we leave the Kimberley region we travel the Tanami Track, visiting the Wolfe Creek meteorite crater before heading to Alice Springs.



## **KIMBERLEY: 21 Day Itinerary (Darwin > Alice Springs)**

- Day 1 We depart Darwin at 7.30am and head south towards Katherine. We visit Edith Falls in the afternoon for an hours walk and swim then camp in Katherine.
- Day 2 From Katherine to Timber Creek with a walk along the way in Gregory National Park.
- Day 3 Timber Creek to Keep River National Park. An afternoon walk.
- Day 4 Crossing into WA we visit Lake Argyle then into Kununurra to camp. We shop for supplies and take a drive around the Ord River Scheme.
- Day 5 North to historic Wyndham with its expansive lookout over Cambridge Gulf and on to camp along the Gibb River Road. (bush camp)
- Day 6 Along the Gibb River Road to Mornington Wilderness camp set in the heart of the King Leopold Ranges for a 3 night camp.
- Day 7 We explore Diamond Gorge and swim at Cadjeput Waterhole.
- Day 8 A day spent walking and swimming at Sir John Gorge.
- Day 9 To Bell Gorge to camp and explore this delightful waterfall.
- Day 10 To Windjana Gorge for a 2 night camp with a visit to Tunnel Creek in the afternoon.
- Day 11 A day walk in Windjana Gorge.
- Day 12 To Derby then on to Broome for a 3 night camp in a caravan park .
- Day 13 Discover Broome township and delightful Cable Beach.
- Day 14 A free day for re-stocking and resting with many different options available to you:
  1. Take a 1/2 day flight to the Horizontal Waterfall & cascades flying over awe inspiring coastal scenery.
  2. More free time in town
  3. 1/2 day pearl farm tour at Willie Creek.
- Day 15 To Fitzroy Crossing to camp and an afternoon cruise in Geike Gorge.
- Day 16 Into Purnululu (Bungle Bungle National Park) for a 3 night camp.
- Day 17-18 Two days spent exploring Cathedral Gorge, Echidna Chasm and Picannini Gorge, (optional extra helicopter flight over Bungle Bungles).
- Day 19 We travel into Halls Creek for supplies and head off across the Tanami Track visiting Wolfe Creek Meteorite Crater. (bush camp)
- Day 20 We travel via Rabbit Flat heading for Alice with a bush camp in the Tanami desert.
- Day 21 Return to Alice Springs.



*NB: Please book onward flights for the next day as road conditions on the Tanami could seriously affect our time of arrival in Alice Springs.*
